PERRYSBURG TOWNSHIP, OH—The Perrysburg Township Police Department enthusiastically announces two ventures to the public: police property auction on PropertyRoom.com and a Citizen's Police Academy.

The Perrysburg Township Police Department use the services provided by PropertyRoom.com to publicly auction off seized, recovered, found, and unclaimed personal property. Close to 3,000 law enforcement, or other municipal agencies, use PropertyRoom.com to conduct auctions. What's great about this service is anyone can bid on the items; one doesn't need to be connected to a law enforcement or governmental entity. Perrysburg Township consistently adds items to the site; therefore one should regularly check PropertyRoom.com in order to review what is available. Another venture announced by the Perrysburg Township Police Department is the newly created Citizen's Police Academy. This program is offered to persons over the age of 21 with Perrysburg Township and City of Perrysburg residents having preference since class size is limited. The classes will begin on April 5, 2012 and continue each Thursday evening, 6:30 p.m. - 9:30 p.m., until May 31, 2012. The classes will focus on providing information related to the operations of the Perrysburg Township Police Department and the duties of officers. Further, various County and State agencies will discuss partnerships which aid in prevention of crime. An application is required and can be obtained from either Sgt.
