The Board of Trustees of Perrysburg Township, Wood County, Ohio, met in regular session on the 1st day of July, 2002, with the following members present:

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Perrysburg Township, Wood County, Ohio, have determined the public safety, convenience and welfare would be served by such regulation; and

WHEREAS, such regulations are applicable to all of the incorporated areas of the Township: therefore be it:

RESOLVED, and hereby determined, under section 505.373 of the Ohio Revised Code, by the Board of Township Trustees of Perrysburg Township, Wood County, Ohio, in order to serve the public safety, convenience and welfare, do hereby adopt a Resolution prescribing regulations consistent with nationally recognized standards for safe guarding, to a reasonable degree, of life and property from the hazards of fire and explosion arising from the storage, handling and use of hazardous substances, materials and devices; and from conditions hazardous to life or property in the use or occupancy of buildings, or premises; known as the Perrysburg Township Fire Prevention Resolution; and incorporating herein a certain document, copies of which are on file at the office of the Perrysburg Township Clerk and the Wood County Library, being marked and designated as "The Ohio Fire Code", being particularly the current editions thereof and current editions of all referenced material from the Ohio Fire Code as published by the Building Officials and Code Administrators International Inc., hereby adopted as the Fire Prevention Resolution of Perrysburg Township, Wood County, Ohio; The Ohio Fire Code, current editions and current editions of all referenced materials as published by the Building Officials and Code Administrators International, Inc. is incorporated herein as fully as if set out in length and copies of the same shall be available for sale to the public at cost in the office of the Perrysburg Township Clerk.

RESOLVED FURTHER, any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of the Ohio Fire Prevention Codes, current edition or current referenced material adopted hereunder, or failing to comply with any lawful order issued pursuant to any article or section thereof shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. Any such violation shall constitute a separate offence on each successive day continued.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the Ohio Fire Code, current editions and current editions of referenced materials as adopted above be and hereby is amended with the addition of section (J) FM-102.8 of the Ohio Fire Code.

The Chief of the Fire Department or his authorized representative shall enforce all provisions of the Ohio Fire Code related to fire prevention in accordance with section 3781.03 of the Ohio Revised Code.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the Perrysburg Township Clerk shall certify to the adopting of this resolution and cause the same to be published as required by law: and this Resolution shall take effect thirty (30) days after adoption and said publication.
