MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT

Agreement for Mutual Aid for Additional Fire and/or Rescuc Protection Pursuant to the Provisions of Section 9.60 of the Ohio Revised Code, and for Emergency Medical Services pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 505.44.

This agreement entered into this 19th day of Sept, 2004 by and between the Township of Monclova, County of Lucas and the Township of Perrysburg, County of Wood, political subdivisions under the laws of Ohio, Witnesseth:

That Whereas, the respective political subdivisions hereinabove named have certain fire fighting and rescue equipment and personnel to operate same, but which in emergencies may be inadequate to afford full and complete protection to said respective subdivisions, the inhabitants thereof, and their respective properties, and,

Whereas, it is desirable that in case of such an emergency said respective parties hereto may have the additional protection which may be afforded by the fire fighting and rescue equipment and personnel of others of the respective parties hereto as may then, in the opinion of the Chief or officer in charge, of such other party hereto as are called upon, IT IS HEREBY MUTUALLY AGREED BY AND BETWEEN SAID PARTIES AS FOLLOWS, to-wit:

1. That for the purpose of affording additional fire protection to themselves, and their inhabitants, the parties hereto do mutually agree to interchange the service of fire departments, and use of fire and rescue equipment and personnel, and to that end, it is hereby agreed that they will assist the party hereto primarily responsible by responding to any fire or rescuc call, from any Chief, or Officer in Charge, or other duly constituted public official of the political subdivision which is a party to this agreement, with it's fire fighting or rescue equipment, or other emergency vehicles and personnel, and will render like services in combating fires or other emergencies as it renders to itself and it's own inhabitants, provided, however, that at no time will the party upon which the request is made, be required to respond with more than one piece of fire or rescuc apparatus upon first alarm, and provided further, that in no case shall the party hereto called upon or rendering such services be liable in damages to any other party hereto or any of it's inhabitants, for failure to answer any fire or rescue call, or for lack of speed in answering any such call, or for any inadequacy of equipment, negligent operation of equipment, failure to extinguish any fire, or for any cause whatsoever growing out of such use of said fire and rescue equipment or other equipment and personnel; nor shall the party hereto, which issued such call be liable in any manner or event for damages or loss of equipment or personnel suffered by the party or parties answering such call.

2. Parties to this agreement may terminate this contract upon thirty days notice, in writing, to the other party.

RESOLUTION

Providing for the execution and delivery of a contract with the Township of Monclova, in Lucas County, Ohio for mutual interchange of fire department services and use of fire and rescue apparatus.

WHEREAS, Perrysburg Township has certain fire fighting and rescue equipment and personnel to operate the same, but which, in emergencies may be inadequate to afford full and complete protection to this Township, the inhabitants hereof, and their respective properties, and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that in such an emergency this Township have additional fire and rescue protection afforded by the fire fighting and rescue equipment and personnel to operate same of the Township of Monclova, Lucas County, Ohio.

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Board of Trustees of Perrysburg Township, Wood County, Ohio:

SECTION 1 That Perrysburg Township enter into a contract for mutual interchange of fire department services and the use of fire and rescue apparatus with the Township of Monclova, a political subdivision in Lucas County, State of Ohio.

SECTION 2 That the Chairman of the Board of Trustees be, and is hereby authorized to execute such a contract on behalf of Perrysburg Township.
