## **RESOLUTION 2005-25**

The Trustees of Perrysburg Township met in regular session on November 21
with Trustees, Craig LaHote, Barbara Gunn, Robert Mack, present at this meeting.
During the course of the meeting the following Resolution was passed on motion by  Robert Mack , and seconded by Barbara Gunn .
WHEREAS, heavy trucks and equipment are using Apex, Broad, and Jefferson streets in Perrysburg Township and it is necessary to have a weight limit of 5000 lbs gross weight placed on these streets: and
WHEREAS, the Board of Township Trustees of Perrysburg Township, Wood County, Ohio, has determined the public safety, convenience and welfare would be served by this regulation: and
WHEREAS, heavy trucks and equipment will cause serious damage to Apex, Broad, and Jefferson streets.
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: that Apex, Broad, and Jefferson streets in Perrysburg Township be posted with a 5,000 lb weight limit and the proper Ohio revised Code procedures be followed and proper signs be placed on said roads effective <u>Dec. 22, 2005</u>
