ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING
January 10, 2011

The Perrysburg Township Zoning Commission held an organizational meeting on January 10, 2011. Robert S. Black, Acting Chairman, called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Grant W. Garn, Zoning Inspector, was also present. The meeting was tape-recorded.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Robert S. Black, Ronald M. Hanna, and Carol Warnimont.

MEMBERS ABSENT: John J. Benavides, Jeff Schaller, Richard Kelsey, and Jeffrey Normand.

ELECTION OF OFFICERS: Mr. Black said the first order of business for their January 10, 2011 organizational meeting is the election of officers.

CHAIRMAN: Mr. Black asked if there was a nomination for the chairman of the Perrysburg Township Zoning Commission. Mr. Hanna nominated Rob Black. Mr. Black asked if there was a second. Ms. Warnimont was the second on the nomination. A roll call vote was taken. Yes votes by Mr. Hanna, Ms. Warnimont, and Mr. Black. Motion carried 3-0-0.

VICE-CHAIRMAN: Mr. Black asked if there was a nomination for vice chairman of the Perrysburg Township Zoning Commission. Ms. Warnimont nominated Jeff Schaller, and Mr. Black was the second on the nomination of Jeff Schaller as vice chairman. A roll call vote was taken. Yes votes by Ms. Warnimont, Mr. Black, and Mr. Hanna. Motion carried 3-0-0.

SECRETARY: Mr. Black said he would nominate Carol Warnimont as secretary of the Perrysburg Township Zoning Commission, and Mr. Hanna was the second on the nomination. A roll call vote was taken. Yes votes by Mr. Black and Mr. Hanna. Ms. Warnimont abstained. Motion carried 2-0-1.

Mr. Black said he only voted for himself because he thought they needed three votes. Ms. Warnimont said she was wondering. She was going to say that, and then she said no, she thinks she did not know if they needed three. Mr. Black said it goes for a majority, and Ms. Warnimont said a majority, doesn't it. Yeah. Mr. Black said he just said yes because he did not know if they needed three votes. Mr. Hanna said not to worry about it. Mr. Garn said his wife paid that price once in her life when she did not

vote for herself for something and lost the election. She thought that she should not. Things happen.

Mr. Black asked if there was a motion to adjourn their organizational meeting. Mr. Hanna moved with a second by Ms. Warnimont to adjourn the organizational meeting. All members were in favor, and none were opposed. The motion carried, and the organizational meeting was adjourned at 6:04 p.m.
