## **RESOLUTION 2014-08**

Authorizing the creation of the Crime Scene Investigation Section, within the Perrysburg Township Police Department

The Board of Trustees of Perrysburg Township, Wood County, Ohio met at a regular meeting of the Board, on March 14, 2014; whereupon the following resolution came on for consideration on the approved agenda of the Board:

WHEREAS, the Perrysburg Township Board of Trustees has deemed it necessary to create, establish, and regulate a Crime Scene Investigation Section within the Perrysburg Township Police Department for the benefit of the Township's criminal investigations

WHEREAS, the Crime Scene Investigation Section will provide accurate and timely scientific analysis of items of physical evidence and reporting the results of those analyses to appropriate entities in the criminal justice community

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Perrysburg Township Board of Trustees as follows:

1. This Board approves and adopts this resolution for the creation of the Crime Scene Investigation Section within the Perrysburg Township Police Department
2. That the purpose of the Crime Scene Investigation Section within the Perrysburg Township Police Department is to improve timeliness of laboratory practices already performed by the Bureau of Criminal Investigation of Ohio in Bowling Green
3. That the creation of this Section will not change the already established procedure of using the Bureau of Criminal Investigation of Ohio to conduct independent external investigations into allegations of serious negligence or misconduct of the Perrysburg Township Police Department
4. That the Crime Scene Investigation Section will use generally accepted laboratory practices and procedures, established by accrediting organizations or appropriate certifying bodies
5. That the equipment used by said Section shall be owned by the Perrysburg Township Police Department and shall be used for the investigations of crimes throughout said township and surrounding areas
6. That it shall be the duty of the Crime Scene Investigator to take charge and custody of all equipment and supervise the maintenance thereof so that the same may be in good order and condition and ready for use at all times

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board and that all deliberations of this Board that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

WHEREUPON Trustee LaHote moved and Trustee Mack seconded the adoption of the Resolution; and the roll was called on the question of adoption thereof; resulting as follows:


