RESOLUTION 2014-20

RESOLUTION OF THE PERRYSBURG TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES CONCERNING THE NECESSITY TO RENEW A 2 MILL LEVY EXCEEDING THE TEN MILL LIMITATION, FOR A 5 YEAR TERM FOR THE PROVISION OF FIRE PROTECTION

The Board of Trustees of Perrysburg Township, Wood County, Ohio met at a regular meeting of the Board, on June 18, 2014 at 6:00 p.m.; whereupon the following was placed in consideration on the regular agenda of the Board:

WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mill limitation is not sufficient to provide adequate funding for the purposes of protection against fire, and to provide and maintain fire apparatus, appliances, for buildings, or sites therefore, sources of water supply and materials therefore, or lines for fire-alarms telegraph, and to pay permanent, part-time, or volunteer fire-fighting personnel or companies to operate such equipment including payment of the employer's contribution under R.C. 742.34 (hereinafter collectively referred to as "fire protection");

WHEREAS, there is currently existing a levy providing funds at a rate not exceeding two (2.0) mills for each one dollar of valuation for the provision of fire protection in Perrysburg Township;

WHEREAS, the last tax year of the currently existing levy is the calendar year, 2013, and the last year of collection of said existing levy is the calendar year, 2014;

WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon the Board of Trustees to renew the currently existing two (2.0) mill levy by declaring the necessity of levying a tax under R.C. 5705.19(1) and 5705.25 outside the ten mill limitation, and request that the Wood County Auditor certify to the Board of Trustees the total current tax valuation of the Township and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the tax as will permit the Board of Trustees to consider the levy of such a renewal tax; and

WHEREAS, the proceedings and hearings on this Resolution, and any necessary notices of such proceedings and hearings have all been undertaken, conducted and given in accordance with applicable law; now therefore

IT IS RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of Perrysburg Township, who voted as certified below: that it is necessary to levy a renewal of the existing tax, in compliance with R.C. 5705.19(1), not exceeding two (2.0) mills for each one dollar of valuation, which is twenty cents (\$00.20) for each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of valuation, in excess of the ten mill limitation, for the purpose of providing fire protection as aforesaid, and that such renewal shall be in effect for another five (5) year term;

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the renewal levy shall be placed upon the property tax list and duplicate for the five (5) year term commencing with tax year 2014 and first due for collection in calendar year 2015, if a majority of the electors vote in favor thereof;

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the question of such tax levy shall be submitted to the electors of Perrysburg Township at the election to be held on Tuesday, November 4, 2014; and


IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Township Fiscal Officer is hereby directed to certify this Resolution to the Wood County Auditor and request the issuance of a Certificate of Estimated Property Tax Revenue.

WHEREUPON Trustee Mack moved and Trustee LaHote seconded the adoption of the Resolution; and the roll was called on the question of adoption thereof; resulting as follows:
