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## **REGULATIONS GOVERNING TRANSIENT VENDORS**

### **BY ORDER OF THE PERRYSBURG TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES:**

#### **1. DEFINITIONS**

- a. "Goods" means goods, wares, services, merchandise, periodicals, and other articles or publications.
- b. "Transient vendor" means any person who opens a temporary place of business for the sale of goods or who, on the streets or while traveling about the township, sells or offers for sale goods, or solicits orders for future delivery of goods where payment is required prior to the delivery of the goods, or attempts to arrange an appointment for a future estimate or sales call. "Transient vendor" does not include any person who represents any entity exempted from taxation under section 5709.04 of the Revised Code, that notifies the board of township trustees that its representatives are present in the township for the purpose of selling or offering for sale goods, or soliciting orders for future delivery of goods, or attempting to arrange an appointment for a future estimate or sales call, and does not include a person licensed under Chapter 4707. of the Revised Code

#### **2. REGISTRATION REQUIRED**

No transient vendor shall sell, offer for sale, or solicit orders for future delivery of goods, without first registering with the Perrysburg Township Police Department. A separate registration must be made for each and every transient vendor selling or soliciting within the Township.

#### **3. INFORMATION TO BE FURNISHED**

Each transient vendor shall, prior to the time of commencement of sale or solicitation, furnish the Township Police Department with the following information on forms provided by the Township Police Department.

- a. Name and date of birth of applicant.
- b. Complete permanent and local address of applicant.
- c. Name and address of the person, firm, corporation or association for whom the solicitation is being made.

- d. A description of the nature of the business and the goods, services or wares to be sold or solicited or otherwise sufficient to identify the subject matter of the selling or soliciting in which the applicant will engage.
- e. The proposed dates and times of the sale or solicitation and the routes to be followed in conducting same.
- f. The make, model, year, color and license plate number of automobiles used by the applicant during the period of solicitation within the Township. The applicant's driver's license and state of issuance or other valid government issued photo identification.
- g. The name and working phone number of applicant's direct supervisor.
- h. A statement whether applicant has been previously convicted of a violation of these regulations or any similar regulations in other jurisdictions.
- i. A statement that applicant is not subject to any wants or warrants in this jurisdiction or any other jurisdiction.
- j. Such information shall be valid for ninety days from the date of its furnishing to the Police Department.

#### **4. RULES AND REGULATIONS**

Every person to whom this Resolution applies shall be governed by the following rules and regulations:

- a. All circulars, samples or other matter shall be handed to an occupant of the property or left in a secure place on the premises.
- b. No transient vendor shall sell or solicit, except between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Eastern Standard Time or Eastern Daylight Time.
- c. No transient vendor shall enter or attempt to enter the house, apartment, or other dwelling unit of any resident in the Township without an express invitation from the occupant of the house or apartment.
- d. No transient vendor shall make any false, fraudulent, misleading or deceptive statement during the course of that person's sales or soliciting activity within the Township.
- e. No transient vendor shall make any solicitation where transient vendors are notified by a sign that soliciting is prohibited.
- f. No transient vendor shall engage in or transact any type of business or solicitation other than that specified on the registration certificate.

- g. No transient vendor shall knock at the door or ring the bell of any home, apartment, apartment building or other dwelling unit in the Township upon which is displayed at the entrance a notice that reads: e.g. "No Transient Vendors Allowed", "No Soliciting", "No Trespassing" or which otherwise clearly purports to prohibit transient vendors on the premises.

## **5. PENALTIES**

Whoever violates this regulation is guilty of a minor misdemeanor. RC 505.99

Whoever falsifies any information required to be provided under this regulation is guilty of falsification, a misdemeanor of the first degree. RC 2921.13

## **6. EFFECTIVE DATE**

These Regulations for Transient Vendors are effective upon notification of the prosecuting attorneys and posting of sufficient signage, which were complete on the 1 day of January, 2015.
